WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY TO DSBN ACADEMY?

· Student must live within the Niagara Region

• Student must be entering grade 6, 7, or 8 in September. (Note: spaces are limited in grades 7 and 8)

• Student would be the first in their family to graduate from a college or university. (If a sibling of the student has attended a post-secondary institution but the parent(s)/guardian(s) have not, the student is still considered a first-generation student.)

• Student must be willing to attend a school location, the DSBN Academy site, which may be outside of their community. Transportation will be provided for these students.



• Student understands there is a mandatory after-school program that enhances the student experience beyond the classroom. These include enrichment opportunities and academic supports. After-school ENCORE enrichment opportunities include: Mixed sports, Chess, Karate, Dance, Zumba, Coding, Mad Science, Board games, Photography, Makerspace, Choir, Canvas painting, Crochet, Crafts, Podcasting, Baking, Debating, Drama and many more!

· DSBN Academy Secondary programming is designed to prepare students for College and University.
